Title: What Kids Wish You Knew About Kids

Using handwritten notes that kids have written to God, interviews, real-life examples, and stories that will leave you wanting more, this breakout will inspire you and help give you a framework for tailoring the discipleship of the kids in your ministry. A little boy is shut down, unresponsive in the corner. A little girl is violent and raging. Another clings to her mom at drop-off. You feel anxious because you don't know what to do. Sound familiar? In this breakout, learn relevant information and practical tools to empower you in ministering to a rapidly growing population of kids with trauma history and mental health issues.

# Breakout 4 | Thursday, February 9 | 1:15-2:15pm CST

Title: Incorporating the Culture of Jesus in Children's Ministry

Category: Discipleship/Outreach | Focus: Spiritual Formation/Cultural Competency
The desire to understand the ways current culture influences how we lead children's ministry
has intensified in recent times. This is particularly the case as it relates to the topics of Kingdom
unity, diversity, and racial reconciliation. What if the best way to gain confidence and clarity in
this is to place emphasis on the culture of the Kingdom we are part of and the King we serve?
What could it look like for us to allow Jesus' culture as a Jewish man to totally influence how we
approach discipleship of children? In part 1 of this 2 part breakout, you will explore the
connections between the culture and humanity of Jesus and the discussion of unity, diversity,
and reconciliation. Leave this session with a refreshing perspective of the "culture" conversation
and how it informs our ministry to children.

Title: Theological Guideposts That Help Lead Children to Christ in Today's Culture

We want every child to enter the Kingdom and walk in discipleship, and we know that following Jesus is a transformational experience, not simply a transactional moment. How do we meet kids where they are in today's culture? How do we equip parents to do this in a way that's theologically sound? In this breakout, let's learn to partner with parents to invite today's kids to



choose to follow Jesus and live out God's plan for their lives through engaging conversations that meet kids at their level and on their terms.
